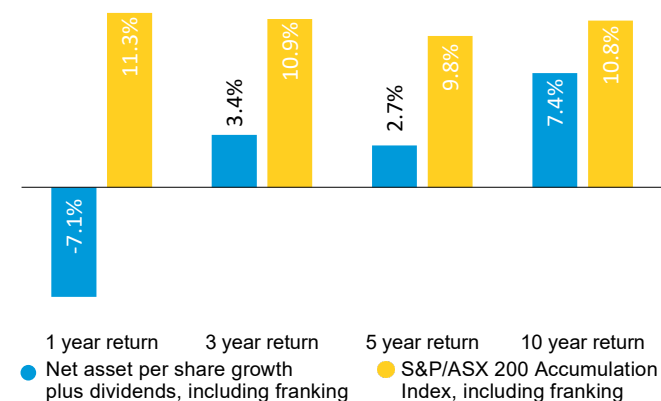

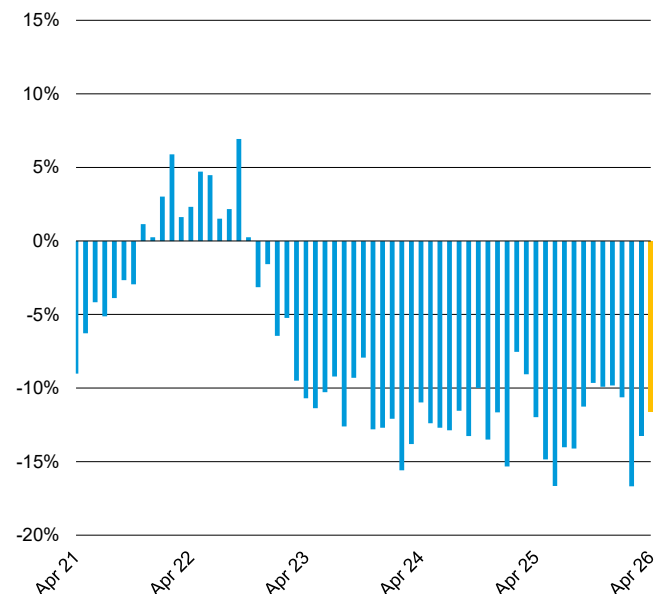
Portfolio performance percentage per annum-periods ending 30 April 2026*

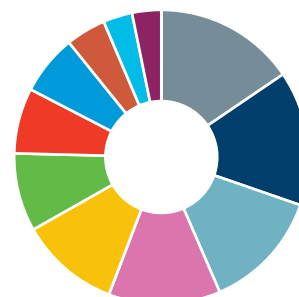
